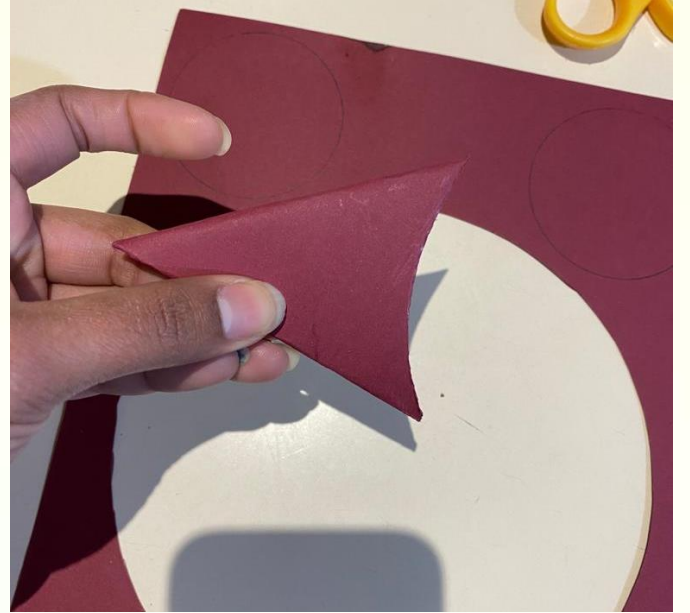




Making Of Umbrella/Godugu for GANESHA

Step1 :

Take a Craft paper in your choice of colour. Draw a circle using a small bowl for template and then cut the paper out.



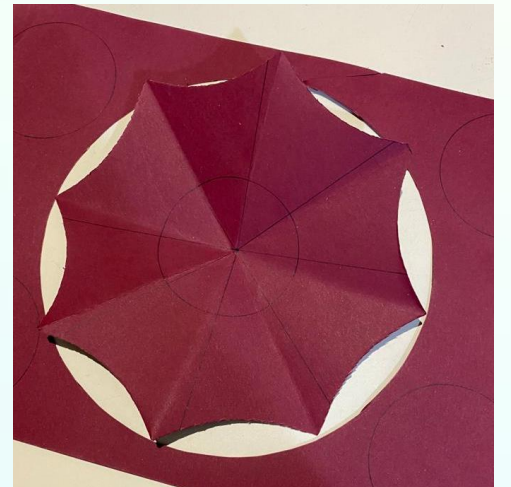
Step2:

Now fold the paper you obtained in the above step into half for three times to form a triangle. Now cut out a small curve on the shorter side of the triangle.

Step3:

Now unfold the paper and then with a pencil, draw lines to separate the creased triangles.

(Note: The circle drawn here over the triangles is for step 5. This is for size reference only)

Step4:

Now cut along one of the line drawn towards the centre and upto the centre.

On the reverse side of the craft paper, apply glue on one side of the cut (i.e., triangle 1) and stick it underneath the other side of the cut (i.e., triangle 2)



Step5:

Take a small cardboard and cut it in a small circle in the size of the circle shown in the figure of step3. Stick the craft paper to one side of it and put a small hole in the centre.

Make sure the size of the hole is smaller than the stick (a icecream or craft popsicle / a chop stick / a wooden skewer etc) you are using.

Now inset the stick into the cardboard a little i.e. upto 2mm and Glue it with craft glue or glue teck or doublesided tape etc. Make sure the colour papered side is towards the bottom side.

Step 6

Now Glue the cardboard with stick to the umbrella we made in step4.



Step 7

Decorate according to your wish
